Verb "to have"

The verb Have is formed by the stem ovor ("there is") and the conjugated object pronoun:

oron – to have

пати́почо	- we have	патипоци	- we don't have
иэтшиночо	- you have (pl)	иэтшиноши	- you don't have (pl)
ториного	- they have	<b>РОТИНОЦÚ</b>	- they don't have
