The sign of the Subject πιωμπι ἀρεφιρι (ἀχε)

In the Coptic language as in any other language there are sentences that begin with a noun (nominal sentences) and others that begin with a verb (verbal sentences). In the verbal sentence the subject is preceded by the sign of the subject hxc.

e.g.


- 1. aqewc hae **Uwr**chc. praised Moses.
- acfine Uapian μπικεμκεμ. took Mary the timbrel.
- 2. arfici hae nimoor. rose the waters.
- 3. Mapeqtorbo nee tekpan. Hallowed be Thy name.
- 4. μαρεζι ήχε τεκμετογρο. come Thy kingdom.

To change a verbal sentence to a nominal sentence, remove **n**xe and begin the sentence with the subject.

e.g.

- ปัชาติด ลงุของ . Moses praised.
- 2. Uapiau ac δι μπικεμκεμ.

 Mary took the timbrel.
- 3. NILLWOY AYTICI.




The waters rose.

Likewise to change a nominal sentence into a verbal one, start the sentence with the verb and add the sign of the subject **hxe** before the subject.

e.g. <u>Verbal sentence:</u>

ачтωмч μαє 1н \overline{c} $\Pi \overline{\chi} \overline{c}$. Rose Jesus Christ.



Nominal sentence:

Ін̄с̄ **П**ҳ̄с̄ ҳqтωnq. Jesus Christ rose.
