*B	В	B or V (will be explained in lesson 5)
*x	Х	K or Sh or Kh (will be explained in Lesson 7)

N.B. The sign (*) indicates the starting point of writing the letter.

Read the following:

CH	PH	cw	PW
HC	HP	WC	WP

Notice the difference in pronunciation between the letters (1, H), Letter (H) takes double the time of letter (1) Also, notice the difference in pronunciation between the letters (0, W), Letter (ω) takes double the time of letter (0)

Then, we mention (01) pronounced (0u) as in tool.

Now we know 13 letters which can be divided into two groups :

- Consonants: Ν, Κ, ͳ, ζ, μ, C, P
- <u>Vowels:</u> 0, ϵ , 1, λ , H, W Read the following:
