The verb in the infinitive form.

1- The verb in the infinitive is used for singular and plural.

Example: A prayer from the vespers.

Ask Him, whom you borne, our Good Savior, to lift these troubles from us, to affirm His peace to us.

Uateo: ask, verb in the imperative mode.
